Mangum, the Capital of the “Empire of Old Greer County” located in the southwest corner of Oklahoma, has a history distinctively its own. Before statehood, Greer County contained 1,571,575 acres, and was larger than the states of Rhode Island and Delaware combined. It consisted of the present counties of Greer, Jackson, Harmon and the southern half of Beckham. It was considered a part of Texas until 1896.

The Old Greer County Museum & Hall of Fame was established at the present location in 1973. The Museum houses numerous historical documents, pictures, artifacts and displays. It is intended that the Museum provide a lasting memorial for those brave Pioneers who carved a home out of this untamed prairie. The Museum is committed to protect and commemorate the people, places and things that represented this area previous to Oklahoma Statehood and hereafter; plus building for future generations. The Museum is a unique place to preserve the knowledge, history and facts regarding Old Greer County.

The Museum is maintained financially by an endowment, donations, annual memberships and a small admission fee.
